HISTORY

On 1997 Father Muller Medical College opened its doors for the aspiring administrators by establishing a hospital administration department as a centre of Father Muller Allied Health Science. It is affiliated to Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Science, Bangalore.

ABOUT THE DEPARTMENT

The department of hospital administration provides a fully-fledged PG course divided into four semesters, on the completion of which the eligible students are awarded with the degree of Masters in hospital administration by RGUHS.

The course provides training to the graduates in the management and administration of the hospitals and health care sectors. The students are trained to inculcate and practice managerial skills that are required in order to become a successful and an efficient administrator. The students are provided with practical training in different units of the hospital along with daily regular theory classes.

ACTIVITIES

- 1. Guest lectures are conducted once in a month and guest speakers are arranged from different fields in order to expose the students to different aspects in the health care management sector.
- 2. Once in a month journal club meet is conducted where in the students discuss topics regarding their research studies and related articles.
- 3. The students are posted to various clinical and non-clinical departments of the hospital in order to provide practical training.

- 4. Once a month the department organizes visits to the various government as well as corporate hospitals. These visitshelp the students get exposed to the various models of health care set up.
- 5. At the end of the third semester, an internship training program for a duration of one month is arranged, where in the students are allowed to work in any hospital of their choice within the country.
