3. Presentation of Feedback Analysis


The feedback analysis was presented – February 2018 from the data procured from the MIS. It was noticed that number of students and faculty participated in the feedback are very less. The points to improve/suggestions were as follows:

- Student feedback: - Some students felt that the use of vernacular languages should be restricted both in college and hostel and more programs could be organized on personality development. They found teachers to be resourceful and approachable; however some teachers were expected to improve their communication to students.
- Students were satisfied with the implementation of curriculum both in theory and practical. Some of them felt that the theory could be completed before the practical postings.
- Parental feedback: Some of them felt that more sports activities can be included in curriculum.

4. Evaluation of the Nutrition, Fitness and Health Expo 2K18

- Sr Deepa Peter, Chairperson of SSPC presented the evaluation report of the Nutrition, Fitness and Health Expo 2K18. A total of 22 stalls were arranged and 9 stalls participated in the competition. The overall feedback suggested that the event was fruitful though the organizers expressed that time utilized for the event was inadequate.
